

# Turtles and their Nests

## What to look for

### Turtle Sighting:

Keep an eye out for:

- \* Turtles basking on logs
- \* Turtles nesting



### Dug up Nests:

Dug up turtle nests will have remains of egg shells scattered around a hole in the ground. If you find egg shells but no holes, the nest may be close by.



## Turtles on the Road:

Be careful driving around during nesting season. Turtles are frequently seen crossing roads in search of new water bodies or nesting sites. If you see a turtle on the road, pull over and move the turtle off the road, in the direction it was travelling.
